This 1 day course will be presented by **Marion Allen**; *Educational Specialist at Family Futures*. She will be demonstrating the use of her new publications; Resource Packs for helping children in the classroom.

The day will focus on the impact of early childhood trauma on children's development and in particular their cognitive development and their executive functioning skills. Ways of assessing children's executive functioning will be discussed and classroom and home based strategies outlined. The day is designed to enhance our understanding of the difficulties, emotional and psychological, that children who are looked after or adopted continue to experience long after they are removed to a place of safety. There is a growing recognition that children remain traumatised, causing them to continue to exhibit difficult behaviour and learning difficulties.
